

**TROY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING
MONDAY, DECEMBER 7, 2020, 5:00 PM**

The Town of Troy Board of Commissioners met in the Board Room of the Troy Town Hall with Mayor Sherri Harris Allgood presiding.

BOARD MEMBERS PRESENT: Mayor Allgood, Mayor Pro Tem Bruce Hamilton, Commissioners Kayren Brantley, Angela Elkins, Wallace Jones and Damon Prince.

BOARD MEMBERS ABSENT: No one was absent.

TOWN STAFF PRESENT: Manager Greg Zephir, Clerk/Finance Officer Cathy Maness, Police Chief James Atkins and Assistant to Manager Dylan Powell.

MEDIA PRESENT: No one was present.

CALL TO ORDER, INVOCATION AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE: Mayor Allgood called the meeting to order and Mayor Pro Tem Hamilton gave the invocation. Mayor Allgood led the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

WELCOME AND SPECIAL RECOGNITIONS: Mayor Allgood welcomed everyone to the meeting.

PUBLIC FORUM: No one was present with comments.

MINUTES of November meeting were approved as written on motion by Comm. Jones and second by Comm. Elkins. All voted approval.

Mayor Allgood took the opportunity to thank the Town for the opportunity to serve. She thanked her husband, family and church for standing with her and she thanked all her constituents. Mayor Allgood stated she looks forward to working with the new mayor and continuing to work for the Town.

MEETING RECESSED at 5:10 PM on motion by Comm. Elkins and second by Comm. Brantley for a presentation and then the swearing in of the newly elected Board Members.

Mayor Pro Tem Hamilton presented a plaque honoring Mayor Allgood for her service to the Town of Troy as Mayor.

Town Clerk Cathy Maness administered the oaths of office to Mayor-Elect Craig Jones and Commissioners-Elect Wallace Jones and Damon Prince.

The new board took their seats and the meeting was reopened. Mayor Jones stated it is a privilege to serve the Town and he looks forward to working with the Town Board.

ORGANIZATIONAL MEETING: Mgr. Zephir stated the organizational meeting is the time when the board makes the appointments for the position of Mayor Pro – Tem, and Town Attorney in addition to the appointment to the Piedmont Triad Regional Council and other rules pertaining to board meetings.

- Nomination and approval of Mayor Pro-Tem – Mayor Jones asked for nominations for Mayor Pro Tem. Comm. Jones made the motion to appoint Comm. Hamilton as Mayor Pro Tem. Comm. Elkins seconded the motion. All voted approval.
- Appointment of the Town Attorney – Mr. Russell Hollers, III – Mayor Jones asked for a motion for appointment of the Town Attorney. Comm. Elkins made the motion to appoint Russell Hollers, III as the Town's Attorney. Mayor Pro Tem Hamilton seconded the motion and all voted approval.
- Appointment to the Piedmont Triad Regional Council – Mayor Jones asked for a motion to appoint the representative to the PTRC. Mayor Pro Tem Hamilton made the motion to appoint Comm. Prince as the Town's representative to the Piedmont Triad Regional Council. Comm. Elkins seconded the motion and all voted approval.

Mayor Jones stated that by consensus of the Town Board the following organizational items were approved as presented:

- Board Meetings follow Roberts Rules of Order
- Public Forum to be held at the beginning of the meeting; individuals are allowed two (2) minutes to speak; cannot yield time to another individual. Public Forum shall not exceed 15 total minutes per meeting.
- Calendar of Board of Commissioner Meeting Dates for 2021



MANAGER'S REPORT:


- Mgr. Zephir informed the Board that beginning next week, the annual testing of all fire hydrants will begin, doing one quadrant of Town each day. There could be some discoloration in the water, but there should be no problems.
- COVID 19 numbers are going up. Troy's employees are being diligent, and we request the Board approve shutting down the public buildings until January 19th. We will still be open, but for appointment only. On motion by Comm. Elkins and second by Comm. Jones the Board approved closing the public buildings to the general public except by appointment. All voted approval. Mgr. Zephir stated we will start tomorrow.
